THE KINGS AND SHEPHERDS TOO AFTER ONE REHERSAL DID A FINE JOB. ARTHUR COOKE, THE ANNOUNCER WHO HAD RECEIVED HIS PART JUST THE PREVIOUS NIGHT CERTAINLY DESERVED CONGRATULATION.
